

**WILSON COUNTY, KANSAS  
OFFICIAL MINUTES**

March 25, 2026

The Board of County Commissioners, Casey Lair, Andrew Miller & Jerry Scott, Kayla Busch, County Clerk, and Kris Marple, County Coordinator, met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Commission Room.

**CALL TO ORDER:** Commissioner Lair called the meeting to order.

**INVOCATION:** Commissioner Miller gave the invocation.

**PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:** Commissioner Scott led the flag salute.

**AGENDA & MINUTES:**

**ACTION:** A motion was made by Commissioner Scott to approve the agenda as presented, and approve the minutes of March 11, 2026 as presented. Commissioner Miller seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

**ROAD & BRIDGE DEPT. REPORT:**

Kary Tatum, Road & Bridge Supervisor, reported that culvert bridge work at 800 & Chase Road was almost completed, and the road crew is asphalt patching. He also presented right-of-way permits for Evergy.

**ACTION:** A motion was made by Commissioner Scott to approve the ROW permits for Evergy as presented. Commissioner Miller seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

**COORDINATOR'S REPORT:**

Kris Marple, County Coordinator, presented Resolution #2026-005 designating the Wilson County Citizen as the official county newspaper from April 1, 2026 to March 31, 2027. He also submitted a letter of support to Senator Jerry Moran for the Granby Street Project funding, and gave a Legislative Update pertaining to pending legislation affecting Counties.

**ACTION:** A motion was made by Commissioner Miller to adopt Resolution #2026-005 as presented. Commissioner Scott seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

**ACTION:** A motion was made by Commissioner Miller to approve the letter of support to Senator Jerry Moran for signature. Commissioner Scott seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

**HEALTH DEPT. REPORT:**

Amy Lell, Health Dept. Administrator, discussed the Regional WIC Dietitian job description, and requested approval to advertise the position as the job will be open on May 1<sup>st</sup> due to retirement. The Commission approved to advertise the position by consensus.

2. Approved warrants in the amount of \$324,128.44 & payroll in the amount of \$130,292.19.
