OFFICIAL MINUTES**

May 28, 2025

The Board of County Commissioners, Casey Lair & Andrew Miller, Kayla Busch, County Clerk, and Kris Marple, County Coordinator, met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Commission Room. Commissioner Jerry Scott was absent.

**CALL TO ORDER:** Commissioner Lair called the meeting to order.

**INVOCATION:** Commissioner Miller gave the invocation.

**PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:** Commissioner Lair led the flag salute.

**AGENDA & MINUTES:**

**ACTION:** A motion was made by Commissioner Miller to approve the agenda as presented, and approve the minutes of May 21, 2025 as presented. Commissioner Lair seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

**ROAD & BRIDGE DEPT. REPORT:**

Kris Marple, County Coordinator, presented a request from the City of Fredonia to waive landfill fees for demolitions at 403 S. 8th, 501 Harrison & 709 N. 5th. And for demolitions in the City of Buffalo at 106 Main & 104 Spruce.

**ACTION:** A motion was made by Commissioner Miller to approve the landfill fee waiver requests as presented. Commissioner Lair seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

**SHERIFF'S REPORT:**

Sheriff Pete Kuhn, presented his FY2026 budget request. He also discussed the Community Health Center of SEK contract renewal for 2026 in the amount of \$72,000.00 effective January 1, 2026.

**ACTION:** A motion was made by Commissioner Miller to approve the 2026 contract with CHCSEK as presented. Commissioner Lair seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

1. County Clerk Kayla Busch, presented an updated list of candidate filings.
2. Approved warrants in the amount of \$116,204.58.
3. Approved payroll in the amount of \$124,273.97.
4. Approved by consensus to cancel the County Commission meeting scheduled for June 4th.
