

**WILSON COUNTY, KANSAS  
OFFICIAL MINUTES**

April 30, 2025

The Board of County Commissioners, Casey Lair, Andrew Miller & Jerry Scott, Kayla Busch, County Clerk, and Kris Marple, County Coordinator, met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Commission Room.

**CALL TO ORDER:** Commissioner Lair called the meeting to order.

**INVOCATION:** Commissioner Miller gave the invocation.

**PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:** Commissioner Scott led the flag salute.

**AGENDA & MINUTES:**

**ACTION:** A motion was made by Commissioner Scott to approve the agenda as presented, and approve the minutes of April 16, 2025 as presented. Commissioner Miller seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

**ROAD & BRIDGE DEPT. REPORT:**

Kary Tatum, Road & Bridge Supervisor, presented a change order for the asphalt crack sealing project from Circle C Paving in the amount of \$22,956.00. He also informed that the John Deere back-hoe needs a new transmission estimated at \$20,000.00, which was approved by consensus to proceed. The Commissioner's also discussed various road concerns & conditions due to the recent rains. He also requested to change Road & Bridge Dept work hours from 6:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on Monday-Thursday, effective May 5<sup>th</sup>, which was approved by consensus.

He also presented the annual maintenance renewal quote from Eaton Corporation for the 911 Dispatch UPS in the amount of \$3,643.85, and the software upgrade quote from Schneider Electric for the HVAC system in the amount of \$17,446.00. He also informed that the annual Relay For Life will be on July 11<sup>th</sup>, and the annual Sausage Fest will be on August 23<sup>rd</sup>. He also submitted a thank you card from John Carlson with Evergy.
