

**WILSON COUNTY, KANSAS  
OFFICIAL MINUTES**

May 21, 2025

The Board of County Commissioners, Casey Lair, Andrew Miller & Jerry Scott, Kayla Busch, County Clerk, and Kris Marple, County Coordinator, met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Commission Room.

**CALL TO ORDER:** Commissioner Lair called the meeting to order.

**INVOCATION:** Commissioner Miller gave the invocation.

**PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:** Commissioner Scott led the flag salute.

**AGENDA & MINUTES:**

**ACTION:** A motion was made by Commissioner Scott to approve the agenda as presented, and approve the minutes of May 14, 2025 as presented. Commissioner Miller seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

**ROAD & BRIDGE DEPT. REPORT:**

Kary Tatum, Road & Bridge Supervisor, reported on traffic counts since the US-75 railroad crossing repairs have been completed. Traffic counts for a 24-hour period were Granby Street 1,750, Tank Avenue 277, Bethel Road 654, and South 4th Street 152. He also reported on mowing roads to cemeteries for the Memorial Day holiday, culvert repairs at 600 & Lane Road, and reclamation at 500 & Edwards Road. He also informed that dust control preparation is being done, and will be starting asphalt repairs in the next 3 weeks.

**COORDINATOR'S REPORT:**

Kris Marple, County Coordinator, presented a Neighborhood Revitalization Plan application for Michael Kleinbeck. He also discussed brush intake at the landfill.

**HEALTH DEPT. REPORT:**

Amy Lell, Health Dept. Administrator, requested to purchase \$1,000.00 of sunscreen for the city pools from the Workforce Development Grant. She also informed that the Healthy Living Action Team is donating bicycles for Fredonia 2nd graders.

**ACTION:** A motion was made by Commissioner Miller to approve the sunscreen purchase as presented. Commissioner Scott seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

**OTHER BUSINESS:**

1. County Clerk Kayla Busch, submitted a request for the Register of Deeds for new index books in the amount of \$2967.92 from Navrat's which was approved by consensus. She also reported that Kim Uden filed for Wildcat Extension District Board.
2. Approved warrants in the amount of \$72,980.98.
