

**WILSON COUNTY, KANSAS  
OFFICIAL MINUTES**

February 18, 2026

The Board of County Commissioners, Casey Lair, Andrew Miller & Jerry Scott, Kayla Busch, County Clerk, and Kris Marple, County Coordinator, met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Commission Room.

**CALL TO ORDER:** Commissioner Lair called the meeting to order.

**INVOCATION:** Commissioner Miller gave the invocation.

**PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:** Commissioner Scott led the flag salute.

**AGENDA & MINUTES:**

**ACTION:** A motion was made by Commissioner Scott to approve the agenda as presented, and approve the minutes of February 4, 2026 as presented. Commissioner Lair seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

**ROAD & BRIDGE DEPT. REPORT:**

Kary Tatum, Road & Bridge Supervisor, discussed patching on 410 Road. He also recommended to submit a bridge at 2000 & Wichita Road, and a bridge at 410 & Udall Road for KDOT funding.

**ACTION:** A motion was made by Commissioner Miller to approve the two bridges for KDOT funding as recommended. Commissioner Scott seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

**COORDINATOR'S REPORT:**

Kris Marple, County Coordinator, presented a landfill fee waiver request from the City of Fredonia for a trailer house located at 1002 N. 8<sup>th</sup> Street on Lot 7 in Fredonia. He also gave a Legislative Update pertaining to pending legislation affecting Counties. He also reported that the local Relay For Life is scheduled for July 10<sup>th</sup> on the Courthouse Square.

**ACTION:** A motion was made by Commissioner Scott to approve the request as presented. Commissioner Miller seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

**HEALTH DEPT. REPORT:**

Amy Lell, Health Dept. Administrator, requested for her & Shanette Smith to attend the Governor's Public Health Conference in the amount of \$1,200.00, which was approved by consensus. Dr. Jennifer McKenney reported on the Federal Rural Health Transformation Program in which Kansas will receive \$221M over the next three years for new rural healthcare services.

**OTHER BUSINESS:**

1. Approved warrants in the amount of \$312,566.37, and payroll in the amount of \$135,903.33.
2. Approved tax roll corrections: 2026-039 to 048.
3. Reports received: Appraiser fees, 911 call stats, and employee overtime.
