

**WILSON COUNTY, KANSAS
OFFICIAL MINUTES**

October 8, 2025

The Board of County Commissioners, Casey Lair, Andrew Miller & Jerry Scott, and Kris Marple, County Coordinator, met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Commission Room. Kayla Busch, County Clerk was absent.

CALL TO ORDER: Commissioner Lair called the meeting to order.

INVOCATION: Commissioner Miller gave the invocation.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: Commissioner Scott led the flag salute.

AGENDA & MINUTES:

ACTION: A motion was made by Commissioner Scott to approve the agenda as presented, and approve the minutes of October 1, 2025 as presented. Commissioner Miller seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

ROAD & BRIDGE DEPT. REPORT:

Kary Tatum, Road & Bridge Supervisor, discussed amending the quote for the Mower Max by extending the boom arm from 26 feet to 30 feet which will change the total amount to \$290,274.29. He also reported on asphalt road project delays. The Road & Bridge Department will go back to 8 hour days, Monday-Friday effective October 13th.

COORDINATOR'S REPORT:

Kris Marple, County Coordinator, presented an estimate to replace the security camera system from A-1 Computers in the amount of \$5,582.00. He also submitted a Neighborhood Revitalization Plan application for Dion Thompson. He also recommended to extend the Solar & Wind Production Moratorium Resolution #2024-016 to October 9, 2026. He also presented the monthly budget reports & October employee birthday cards for signature.

ACTION: A motion was made by Commissioner Miller to approve the estimate from A-1 Computers as presented. Commissioner Scott seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

ACTION: A motion was made by Commissioner Scott to approve the NRP application as presented. Commissioner Miller seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

ACTION: A motion was made by Commissioner Miller to extend Resolution #2024-016 to October 9, 2026. Commissioner Scott seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

HEALTH DEPT. REPORT:

Amy Lell, Health Dept. Administrator, reported that WIC is fully funded through October but it's been recommended that a contingency plan be in place if the Federal Government shutdown extends into November. She also gave an update on a sanitary code violation on Oak Hill Road. A final warning will be delivered by the Sheriff's Dept. If the matter isn't resolved, then a \$100.00 per day penalty violation will be cited.

APPRAISER'S REPORT:

Jessica Porter, County Appraiser, reported that the Jeep has been fixed. She also discussed quotes for a new Canon color copier on a lease-purchase from McCarty's in the amount of \$4,200.00, which was approved by consensus.
