

**WILSON COUNTY, KANSAS
OFFICIAL MINUTES**

January 21, 2026

The Board of County Commissioners, Casey Lair, Andrew Miller & Jerry Scott, Kayla Busch, County Clerk, and Kris Marple, County Coordinator, met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Commission Room.

CALL TO ORDER: Commissioner Lair called the meeting to order.

INVOCATION: Commissioner Miller gave the invocation.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: Commissioner Scott led the flag salute.

AGENDA & MINUTES:

ACTION: A motion was made by Commissioner Scott to approve the agenda as amended, and approve the minutes of January 14, 2026 as presented. Commissioner Miller seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

ROAD & BRIDGE DEPT. REPORT:

Kary Tatum, Road & Bridge Supervisor, presented a list of eligible bridges for KDOT funding for submission by February 20th. The matter was tabled until next meeting.

COORDINATOR'S REPORT:

Kris Marple, County Coordinator, presented Resolution #2026-004 adopting a Vision Zero Policy and Proclaiming Wilson County's commitment to reduce traffic fatalities and serious injury accidents in Wilson County by 2031 and implementation of a safe streets and roads for all plan. He also submitted a request to appoint Barb Baker to the New Beginnings Board as a Wilson County board member for a 3-year term. He also gave a legislative update.

ACTION: A motion was made by Commissioner Miller to adopt Resolution #2026-004 as presented. Commissioner Scott seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

ACTION: A motion was made by Commissioner Scott to appoint Barb Baker to the New Beginnings Board as a Wilson County board member for a 3-year term. Commissioner Miller seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

OTHER BUSINESS:

1. The County Commission consented to cancel their February 11th meeting.
2. Amy Lell, Health Dept. Administrator, reported that 6 computers in her department need replaced and she's getting quotes which 60-80% will be paid for by grant funding. She also discussed the Variant K flu strain that wasn't covered by the flu shot vaccine.
3. Approved warrants in the amount of \$123,901.71, and payroll in the amount of \$127,566.84.
4. Reports received: Employee overtime.
