

**WILSON COUNTY, KANSAS  
OFFICIAL MINUTES**

August 6, 2025

The Board of County Commissioners, Casey Lair, Andrew Miller & Jerry Scott, Kayla Busch, County Clerk, and Kris Marple, County Coordinator, met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the Commission Room.

**CALL TO ORDER:** Commissioner Lair called the meeting to order.

**INVOCATION:** Commissioner Miller gave the invocation.

**PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:** Commissioner Scott led the flag salute.

**AGENDA & MINUTES:**

**ACTION:** A motion was made by Commissioner Scott to approve the agenda as presented, and approve the minutes of July 30, 2025 as presented. Commissioner Miller seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

**COORDINATOR'S REPORT:**

Kris Marple, County Coordinator, submitted the Local Disaster Recovery Plan for approval. He also discussed a request to waive landfill fees for the house demolition at 621 N. 10<sup>th</sup> in Fredonia. He also presented a letter of resignation by Julie Lair from the Wilson Medical Center Board of Trustees, which was accepted by consensus. He also submitted \$0.50 per hour pay increase requests for Deputy Sheriff Jeffrey Postier & Corrections Officer Annalyn Hammond due to completing their introductory periods. He also reported that the asphalt road repairs project will start on Monday. He also discussed a request to designate a truck route for Twin Rivers Industrial Park due to accident on Tank Avenue, which was tabled until further information is obtained. He also presented the August employee birthday cards for signature.

**ACTION:** A motion was made by Commissioner Miller to approve a landfill fee waiver for 621 N. 10<sup>th</sup> as presented. Commissioner Scott seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

**ACTION:** A motion was made by Commissioner Miller to approve the pay increase requests for Jeffrey Postier & Annalyn Hammond as presented. Commissioner Scott seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

**COUNTY CLERK'S REPORT:**

Kayla Busch, County Clerk, reported that Revenue Neutral Rate Hearing Notices were mailed on Tuesday.

**OTHER BUSINESS:**

1. Jessica Porter, County Appraiser, reported that her department is in substantial compliance with the State Division of Property Valuation. She is also still accepting applications for the vacant data collector position.
2. Dean Silvey expressed his opinions on best prices versus best practices when spending tax money.
3. Approved payroll in the amount of \$120,988.22.
