FRIDAY, DECEMBER 1, 2023

Deadline for political parties to opt out of participating in the Presidential Preference Primary.

TUESDAY, JANUARY 2

Deadline for political parties to submit the party rules for delegate allocation to the Kansas Secretary of State.

TUESDAY, JANUARY 16

Deadline for political parties to notify the Kansas Secretary of State who is eligible to vote in each party's Presidential Preference Primary.

MONDAY, FEBRUARY 19

Deadline to register to vote or update voter registration information to participate in the Presidential Preference Primary.

Last day to apply for an advance voting mail ballot.

WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 28

First day of advance voting. Advance ballots by mail are transmitted. In-person advance voting may begin. Check with your county election officer for specific times and locations.

MONDAY, MARCH 18 In-person advance voting ends at 12:00 p.m.

TUESDAY, MARCH 19 PRESIDENTIAL PREFERENCE PRIMARY ELECTION
